Uncountable nouns

These are also called **MASS** nouns and indicate a **QUANTITY** and thus take **LITTLE** and need to be quantified by another noun: *a glass of water, a piece of paper, some information, a drop of blood.*

Some of these can take a plural but they then indicate "different types of": you can use various spellings with this program, they have different sugars in the bars.

Just remember: NO PLURAL
